Warranty will be void if the customer can not provide the original sales receipt. Do not install a body lift in conjunction with a suspension system. If a body lift is used in conjunction with any Tuff Country EZ-Ride Suspension product, your Tuff Country EZ-Ride Suspension WARRANTY WILL BE VOID. Tuff Country Inc. ("Tuff Country") suspension products are warranted to be free from defects in material and workmanship for life if purchased, installed and maintained on a non-commercial vehicle; otherwise, for a period of twelve (12) months, from the date of purchase and installation on a commercial vehicle, or twelve thousand (12,000) miles (which ever occurs first). Tuff Country does not warrant or make any representations concerning Tuff Country Products when not installed and used strictly in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions for such installation and operation and accordance with good installation and maintenance practices of the automotive industry. Important information that needs to be read before installation begins:

This kit will only work on vehicles that are equipped with 4" rear axle tube. If the vehicle that you are working on does not have a 4" rear axle tube, please do not contact Tuff Country but please contact the company that you purchased the kit from to return it.

Tuff Country EZ-Ride Suspension packages (2) sets of instruction sheets with this box kit. (1) is for the installer and (1) is for the customer. The (1) for the customer has some post installation procedure literature and it is the installers responsibility to make sure that the customer receives a copy of the installation manual along with the literature.

Before installation begins, Tuff Country EZ-Ride Suspension highly recommends that the installer performs a test drive on the vehicle. During the test drive, check to see if there are any uncommon sounds or vibrations. If uncommon sounds or vibrations occur on the test drive, uncommon sounds or vibrations will be enhanced once the suspension system has been installed. Tuff Country EZ-Ride Suspension highly recommends notifying the customer prior to installation to inform the customer of these issues if they exist.

Make sure to use loctite on all new and stock hardware associated with the installation of this suspension system.

Special note: Before installation begins, it is the customers/installers responsibility to make sure that all parts are on hand. If any parts are missing, please feel free to call one of our customer service representatives @ (801) 280-2777.

All the pictures in this installation are on the driver side!

Please follow instructions carefully:

1. To begin installation, block the front tires of the vehicle so that the vehicle is stable and can't roll forward. Safely lift the rear of the vehicle and support the vehicle with a pair of jack stands. Place a jack stand on both the driver and the passenger side.

 Working on the driver side, remove and save the nut from the bolt that connects the spring into the spring hanger. Repeat procedure on passenger side.



3. Locate the new driver and passenger side front traction bar bracket. Working on the driver side, install the new front bracket over the OE spring hanger and secure using the OE nut. **Make sure to use loctite and torque to 110 ft lbs**. Repeat procedure on the passenger side.








4. Working on the driver side and using the newly installed front traction bar bracket as a guide, carefully drill 3 holes into the OE hanger. Repeat procedure on the passenger side.



5. Locate (6) 3/8" x 1" bolts, (6) 3/8" unitorque nuts and (12) 5/16" USS flat washers from hardware bag 30991NB. Working on the driver side, install the new 3/8" hardware to the previously drilled holes. **Make sure to use loctite and torque to 28 ft lbs.** Repeat procedure on the passenger side.




6. Place a hydraulic floor jack under the rear axle. Place one on the driver and passenger side. Carefully raise up on both hydraulic floor jacks until they make contact with the rear axle.

7. Working on the driver side, loosen but do not remove the rear u-bolts. Loosen just enough for the new rear traction bar bracket to be installed between the u-bolts and axle. Repeat procedure on the passenger side.



8. Locate the new rear traction bar brackets. Working on the driver side, install the new bracket between the u-bolts and the axle. Torque the u-bolts to 125 ft lbs. Repeat procedure on the passenger side.



9. Remove the hydraulic floor jacks from under the vehicle. Also, carefully lower the vehicle to the ground. 10. With the vehicle on the ground and working on the driver side, measure from the new front traction bar bracket to the rear axle traction bar bracket to get the length of what the new rear traction bar needs to be set at. Record measurement here.

11. Locate the new bushings, sleeves and poly lube packs from hardware bag 30991NB. Install the new bushings and sleeves into the new rear traction bars. Special note: Make sure to use a lithium or moly base grease prior to inserting the bushings and sleeves into the new rear traction bars. This will help increase the life of the bushings as well as prevent squeaking.

 Locate the new hiem joints and install them into the new rear traction bars. Refer back to the measurements from step # 10 and set each traction bar to the proper length.

13. Locate (4) 9/16" x 4" bolts, (4) 9/16" unitorque nuts and (8) 1/2" USS flat washers from hardware bag 30991NB. Working on the driver side, install the new traction bar to the newly installed traction bar mounts using the new 9/16" hardware. Make sure to use loctite and torque to 80 ft lbs. Special note: the hiem joint end of the traction bar will be installed to the front bracket. Also, make sure to install it with the sert fitting facing downward. Repeat procedure on the passenger side.

14. Working on the driver side, tighten the hiem joint jam nut. Repeat procedure on the passenger side.



15. Check and double check to make sure that all steps were performed properly and check again.



Congratulations, installation complete!

Tuff Country EZ-Ride Suspension recommends that a complete re-torque is done on all bolts associated with this suspension system. It is the customers responsibility to make sure that a re-torque is performed on all hardware associated with this suspension system after the first 100 miles of installation. It is also the customers responsibility to do a complete re-torque after every 3000 miles or after every off road use. Neglect of following these steps could cause brackets to come loose and cause serious damage to the suspension system and to the vehicle.
